Goals of the action

- Integrated transnational Master study programmes
- Excellence and global internationalisation of the HEIs in Europe & attracting talent to Europe
- International consortia of European and global HEIs and eventually other partners (academic or non-academic: full or associated)
- Foster academic cooperation within the EHEA



Requirements (I)

- Consortium of at least **3 HEIs from 3 countries** (min. 2 HEIs from programme countries)
- Master programme open to students worldwide
- **Compulsory physical mobility** for all students (at least 2 semesters (30 ECTS) in 2 countries, min. 1 in a programme country)
- Grant for 72 months, at least 4 editions (1 or 2 year Master, 60, 90 or 120 ECTS)



Requirements (II)

- Contribution of guest lecturers to teaching, training and research activities
- Commitment to enrol certain number of students
- Geographical balance of students

 (max. 10% of total scholarships per project to
 students of the same nationality NA for additional
 scholarships for targeted regions IPA III and NDICI)



The grant

• Unit costs based on 3 components:

1) Institutional costs – €750 per student, max. 100 (implementation costs - staff & organ. costs, guest lectures, promotion, accom. assistance & other student services)

2) Scholarships – €1400 per student, max. 60 (subsistence, installation and travel + fee waiver)

3) Individual needs top-up – €3 000 - €60 000 per student, max. €120 000 per project
(cover individual needs of students with disabilities)



Taking part

- Programme country HEIs: valid ECHE
- Partner country HEIs: commit to ECHE principles in the Partnership Agreement
- Coordinator: any eligible HEI from Programme or Partner country
- Full partner: HEI or private/public organisation actively contributing to the delivery of the joint Masters degree
- Complete evaluation/accreditation when applying
