



European University Alliances



Scope and objectives

- Key initiative to achieve the EEA and the transformation of HE
- Key role in other EU strategies
- Transnational extensive deep long-term institutional cooperation based on common values and principles
- Mobilizing all 4 missions of HEIs (education, research, innovation, service to society)
- Currently 50 Alliances (over 430 HEIs)
- Target: 60 Alliances by mid-2024



Practical information – Call 2024

- 2 topics Development of deep institutional transnational cooperation + Community of practice
- News: higher evaluation threshold from 70 to 80 points
- Total available budget: 187,7 mil. EUR (grant per Alliance approx. 3 -14 mil.) +
 1,5 mil. for the Community of practice
- **Deadline**: 6 February 2024, 17:00



Alliances for Innovation



Scope and objectives

- Boosting innovation through cooperation between HE, VET and broader socioeconomic environment, including research
- Talent and skills development (including green and digital skills)

Practical information – Call 2024

Alliances for Education and Entreprises

- Min. 8 organizations from 4 countries (min. 3 labour market actors + 3 VET, HE education providers)
- Duration: 2/3 years
- Max. grant: 1/1,5 mil. EUR
- Deadline: 7 March 2024



Virtual Exchanges in Higher education and Youth



Scope and objectives

- International and cross-cultural education without physical mobility
- Intercultural dialogue with 3rd countries not associated to the Programme
- Enhancing critical thinking, media literacy, digital and soft skills
- Promoting citizenship and common values
- Various types of online exchanges (discussions, open online courses,...)
- Promoting cooperation between HE and Youth



Practical information – Call 2024

- Exchanges moderated by trained facilitator
- Ensuring safety and open access for all interested participants
- Minimum 4 organizations from 4 countries (2 "programme" countries + 2 "partner" countries from the same region)
- Eligible regions: 1, 2, 3, 9 (+ geographical priorities and targets)
- Duration: 3 years
- Max. grant: 500 000 EUR (200 per participant → max. grant = 2500 participants)
- **Deadline**: 25 April 2024



Possibilities for HEIs in VET sector



Centres of vocational excellence (CoVE)

- together with EUI 2nd flagship of the Erasmus+
- supporting reforms, excellence and high quality skills in VET sector
- two levels: national (regional strategies and skills ecosystems) and international
- min. 8 organizations from 4 programme countries (min. 1 enterprise + min. 1 VET provider from 4 countries)
- Duration and budget: 4 years, max. 4 mil. EUR
- Deadline: 7 May 2024



Capacity building in VET

- international cooperation and capacity building of VET sector in third countries (work-based learning, quality assurance, key competences, PD, innovation,...)
- supporting cooperation between private and public providers
- min. 4 organizations from 3 countries (min. 1 org. from 2 "programme" countries + 2 org. from 1 "partner" country)
- Duration and budget: 1/2/3 years, max. 400 000 EUR
- Deadline: 29 February 2024
