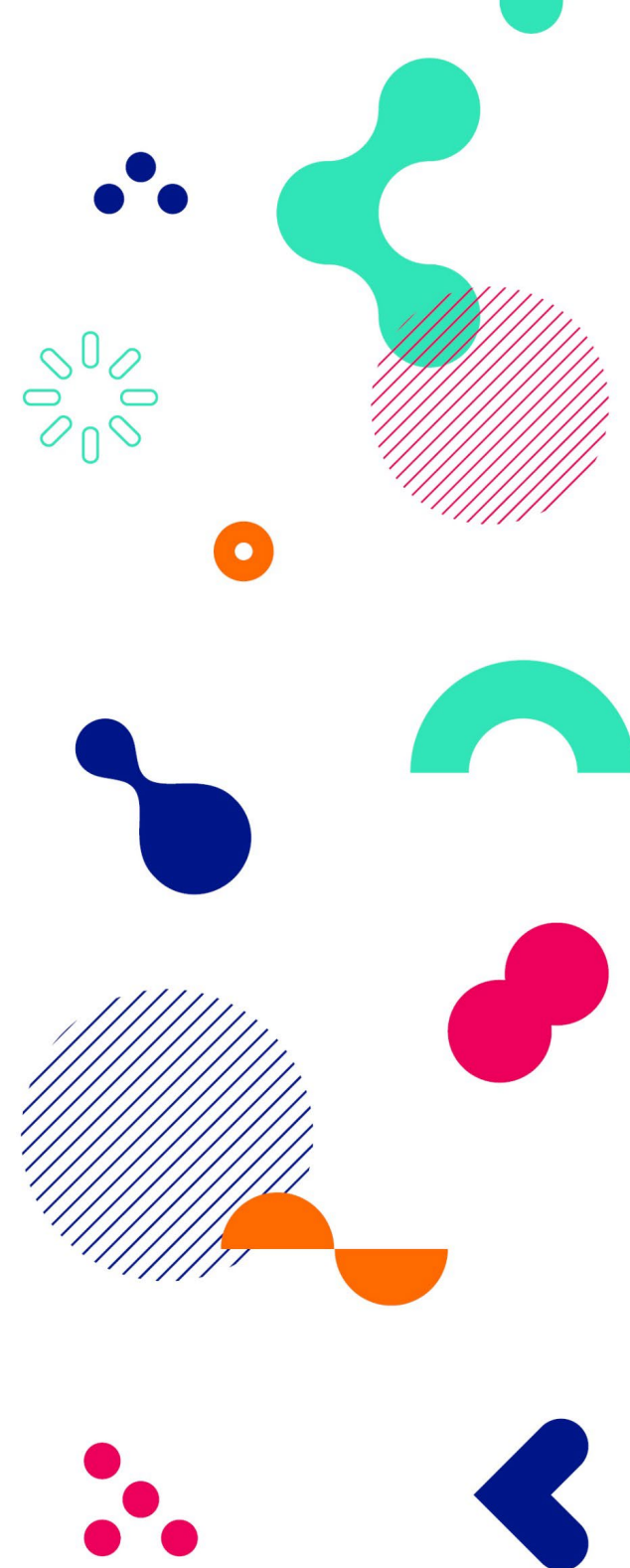

# Priorities of Kyrgyzstan on higher education:



- ❖ Development and adoption of the national project "3-200-2040," where the three leading universities of the country will be among the top 200 universities in the world by 2040 in leading global rankings (Times Higher Education, Academic Ranking of World Universities, U.S.News, Shanghai Ranking).
- ❖ Consolidation of state resources for the development of a limited group of universities based on the principle of further regional specialization in high-demand fields (e.g., medicine, scientific and technical disciplines).
- ❖ Ensuring targeted training of scientific personnel and youth in scientific specialties aligned with the country's science and industrial innovation development priorities in accordance with the National Development Strategy of the Kyrgyz Republic.
- ❖ Development and implementation of scientific and innovation programs carried out jointly by university groups and scientific organizations.
- ❖ Increasing the funding for internships of young promising scientists abroad and inviting globally renowned scientists.



# Priorities of Erasmus+ for Central Asia

**Green Deal** - Higher Education systems are crucial for supporting the Green Deal, potentially enabling a profound change in peoples' behaviour and skills.

CBHE projects are encouraged to develop competences in various sustainability-relevant sectors, green sectorial skills strategies and methodologies, as well as future-oriented curricula that better meet the needs of individuals. Erasmus+ also supports the testing of innovative practices to prepare learners and higher education providers to become true agents of change.

**Sustainable growth and jobs** - Education is needed to build skills for life and work, such as foundational skills, 'soft' skills (e.g. problem solving, communication), and Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths (STEAM). Education also supports employability and is a precondition for sustainable growth.

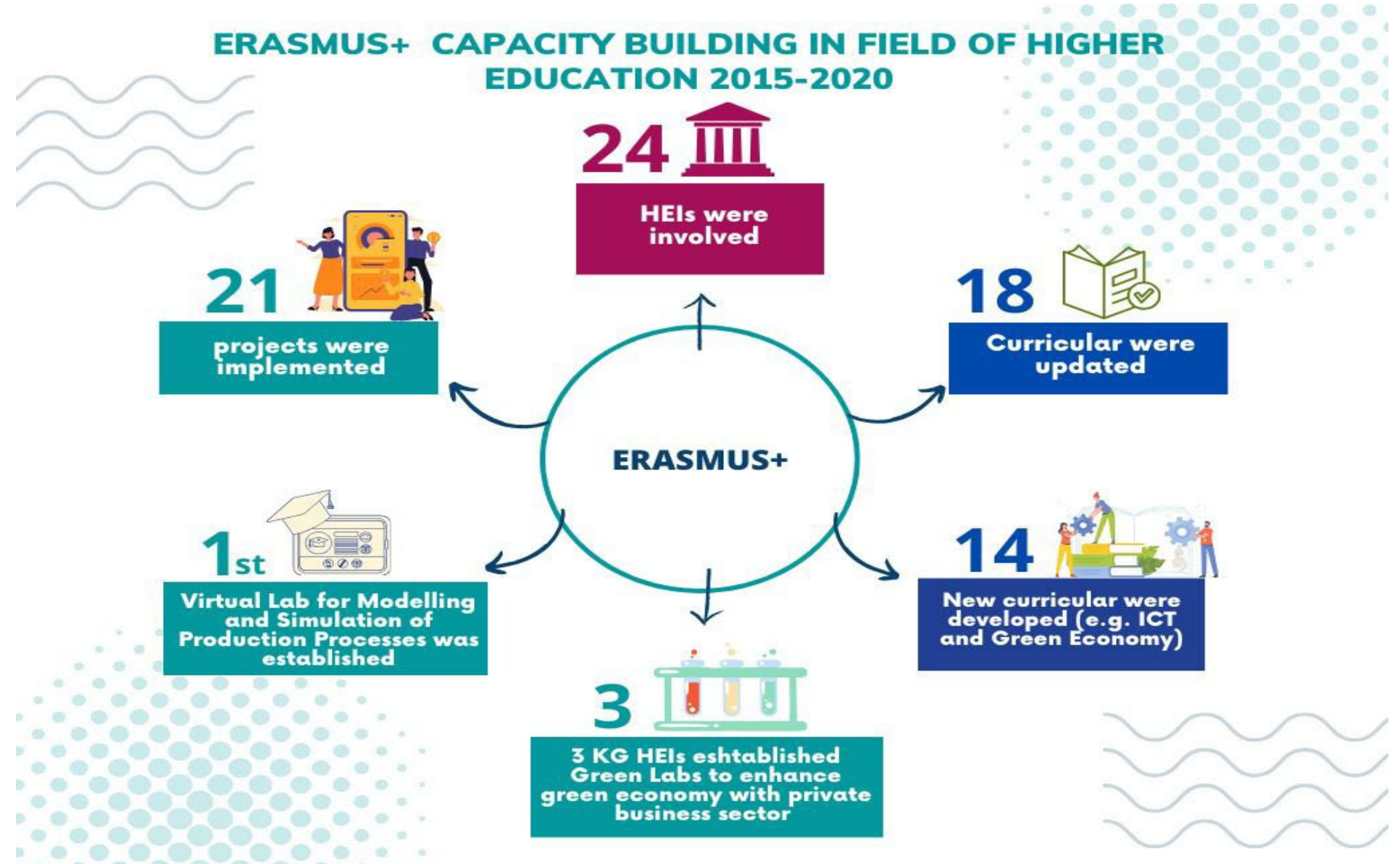
