# **Objectives**

- Enhance the relevance of HE for the implementation of the Global Gateway strategy
- Improve the quality of HE and enhance its relevance for the labour market and society
- Improve the competences, skills and employability of students by developing innovative curricula
- Promote inclusive education, equality, equity, non-discrimination and civic competences in HE
- Enhance the teaching, assessment mechanisms, QA, management, governance, inclusion, innovation, knowledge base, digital and entrepreneurial capacities, and the internationalisation of HEIs
- Increase the capacities of HEIs and authorities to modernise the HE systems, governance and financing, by supporting reform processes
- Improve the training of teachers and continuous professional development
- Stimulate cooperation of institutions, capacity building and exchange of good practice

- Foster engagement by HEIs with community and industry stakeholders

# **Project Types and Requirements for Consortia**

#### Project types:

- "National projects" involving HEIs from only one third countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme (for Regions 2, 3, 5a, 6, 7a, 8a, 9 only)
- "Multi-country (regional) projects" involving HEIs from more than one third countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme but within one region
- "Multi-country cross-regional" involving HEIs from more than one region (cross-regional)

#### Minimum requirements for a consortium:

- 1 HEI from 2 different countries from: EU27, IS, LI, MK, NO, RS or TR
- At least 2 HEI from each participating third countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme in the project
- For Strand 3: National competent authority responsible for HE is required

# Strand 1: Fostering access to cooperation in HE

- Facilitate access to newcomers
- Reach out to people with fewer opportunities
- Reduce the internationalisation gap of HEIs from the same country or region
- HEIs from LDC or located in remote areas
- Activities:
  - Enhancing the management/administrative capacity of the targeted HEIs
  - Ensuring high quality and relevant education
  - Increasing the accessibility of the students/staff with fewer opportunities
- **Duration:** 2 or 3 years; **Funding:** 200.000 400.000 Euro (max. 90% of total costs)



# Strand 2: Partnerships for transformation in HE

- Innovation in HE in order to enhance its relevance for the labour market and the society
- Promoting reform in HEIs to become catalysts of economic and social development
- Activities, e.g.:
  - Designing innovative curricula and implementation of innovative learning and teaching methods
  - Innovation in HE targeting labour market and society
  - Engagement with the business world and research
  - Strengthening the HEIs capacities to network
  - Modernising HEIs by promoting reform
  - Reform governance and management at HEIs
- **Duration:** 2 or 3 years; **Funding:** 400.000 800.000 Euro (max. 90% of total costs)



# Strand 3: Structural reform projects

Develop coherent, inclusive and sustainable systems of HE to meet their socio-economic needs
and broad ambition to create a knowledge-driven economy, including STEM

#### Activities:

- Cooperation and mutual learning among public authorities for innovating the HE sector
- Promote inclusive HE systems
- Increase capacities of HE bodies to modernise the HE system
- Identify synergies with ongoing EU initiatives (e.g., Global Gateway priorities for 5a, 6, 8a, 9,10, 11)
- Important: national competent authority responsible for HE is required
- **Duration:** 3 or 4 years; **Funding:** 600.000 1.000.000 Euro (max. 90% of total costs)

# **Budget Overview 2026**

Total Budget available: 27,663,570 EUR

• JMA in the field of HE (Modules, Chairs, Centres of Excellence)

15,663,570 EUR (H2: 11 000 000; H6: 4 663 570 EUR)

• Other fields of education and training (Teacher Training, Learning EU Initiatives)

7,800,000 EUR

 Policy Debate (Networks for HEI, Networks for schools and VETs)



4,200,000 EUR (H2: 3 000 000; H6: 1 200 000 EUR)



#### Modules

- short teaching programmes or courses in the field of European Union studies
- minimum duration of 40 teaching hours per academic year
- one particular discipline in European studies or a multidisciplinary approach
- direct contact hours (no individual tutorials)
- short specialised or summer programmes (distance learning)





#### Chairs

- teaching posts with a specialisation in European Union studies
- held by only one professor (permanent staff members)
- minimum 90 teaching hours per academic year
- additional hours and support of other staff are possible









## **Centres of Excellence**

- focal points of competence and knowledge on EU subjects
- synergies between the various disciplines and resources in European studies
- reaching out to students from faculties not normally dealing with EU issues
- only one at a time per HEI
- should seek to become structured centres providing EUspecific high-level knowledge





# **Specifications**

- single HEI application
- HEIs from all countries <u>except</u> Belarus and the Russian Federation
- duration: 3 years
- maximum grant:
  - module: 30 000 €
  - chair: 50 000 €
  - centre of excellence: 100 000 €
- co-financing: **75** % (module, chair); **80** % (centre of excellence)
- funding model: fixed lump sum (module, chair); customized lump sum (centre of excellence)





# **Teacher Training**

- develop new skills, to teach and engage on EU matters
- better understanding of the EU and its functioning
- deliver specific individual or group training courses (modular, residential, blended or online) for teachers interested in the EU and willing to integrate EU subjects in their daily work
- for teachers in schools and Vocational Education and Training (VET) providers

#### **Applicant**:

- HEI providing initial and/or in-service training to teachers of schools and/or VET institutions (ISCED 1 - 4); or
- Teacher Training / Education Institution / Agency providing initial and/or in-service training to teachers, schools, and/or VET institutions (ISCED 1 - 4)



# **Specifications**

- single HEI application
- HEIs from EU member states or third countries associated to the programme
- duration: 3 years
- maximum grant: 300 000 €
- co-financing: 80 %
- funding model: customized lump sum





#### **Thematic Networks**

- Large thematic networks in Higher Education are created to collect, share, and discuss among the partners research findings, content of courses, experiences, and products (studies, articles, etc.)
- A tool allowing the partners to share these must be established as part of the project
- The coordinator of the network will regularly make a selection of the most innovative and interesting results to be provided to the Commission.

In 2026, two thematic networks are foreseen in HE:

- A. Network on Internal Policy: A resilient Single Market to boost EU competitiveness
- B. Network on External Policy: *EU-India*





# **Specifications**

- application: at least 12 partners (depending on type of network)
- HEIs from: EU member states or third countries associated to the programme + third countries (depending on the type of network)
- duration: 3 years
- maximum grant: 1 000 000 € 1 200 000 € (depending on the type of network)
- co-financing: 80 %
- funding model: customized lump sum







# **Call Timeline 2026**

STEPS	DATES
Publication of the call 2026	November 2025
Deadline for submission of applications	3 February 2026
Evaluation period	April – June 2026
Notification of results to applicants	Max. 6 months after submission deadline
Preparation of Grant Agreement/Decision	Max. 9 months after submission deadline
