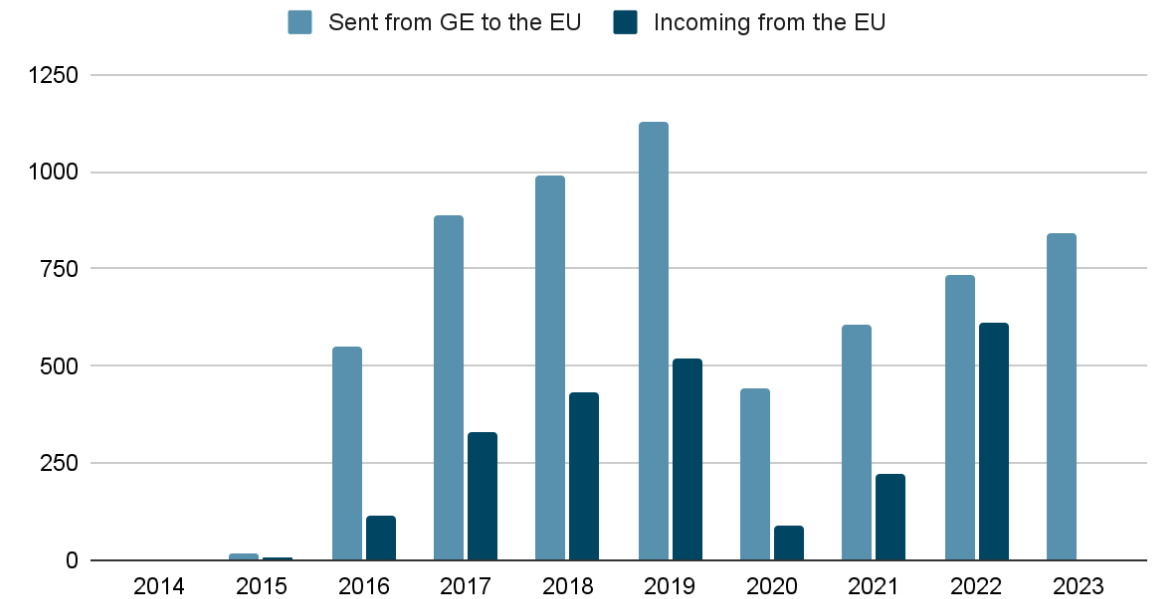
GEORGIA in Erasmus+

- **JMA** - 38 pr. coordinated by GE



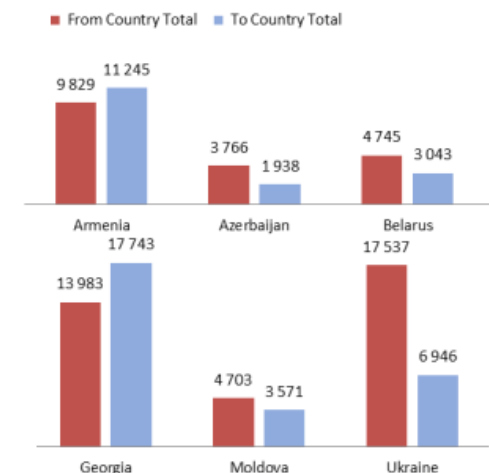

- **Youth Mobility Projects:** Popular among youth and HEI communities.
